

If the fire is coming to you closer and closer:

- Let someone know where you are;
- Find a safe escape route: a road or a waterway;
- Protect yourself from the smoke and avoid breathing: a wet clothing on the mouth can help you;
- Find a safe place to stay, far from vegetation.

To Prevent the Fire

- Do not throw away cigarette butts or matches still lit, even from the car: they can ignite a fire;
- Do not light fires in the green areas and parks. Use only equipped areas and never leave a fire unattended. Make sure it is completely extinguished before leaving: use water;
- Do not leave the waste in the woods or on the roadsides. It is a dangerous fuel;
- From June 15th to September 30th, do not burn agricultural waste without proper safety measures. Just a few minutes and the fire can get out of your control.

To Prevent the Fire

- Make a fire safe zone around your house: clean it from flammable vegetation and waste;
- Tell your children emergency numbers to dial and what to do in case of emergency;
- If you are with your friends, encourage them to follow these simple rules.

Always remember that even a small flame can turn into a major fire.

When the fire is in progress:

- Immediately call the emergency numbers. Don't assume that others have already done. Provide the necessary information to locate the fire:
 - 112 (Common Emergency Telephone Number)
 - 115 (National Fire Department)
 - 803 555 (SOUP - Lazio Region Operations Centre)
 - 800 854 854 (SO - Roma Capitale Operations Room)
- The fire is not a show, quickly move away and do not stop along the driveway. You could hamper rescue operations and the communication necessary to manage the emergency;
- Follow the instructions of emergency coordinators.
