

### Permanent officials (civil servants)






#### Assistants = Non-university degree AST/SC = secretaries AST/1 AST/2 AST/3 (up to AST/9)

#### **Coronavirus – Important information**

#### **Computer-based tests**

- CBT tests are ongoing
- Taking into account the different rules in place and the differing re-opening times, social distancing and hygiene measures
- Candidates must wear a mask

#### **Assessment Centre tests**

- EPSO had to suspend all its Assessment Centre activities
- Not possible to organise the tests with the physical presence of candidates in EPSO premises in the near future
- EPSO is looking into organising the AC tests in an online format (remote)

#### **Coronavirus – Important information**

#### What is remote testing?

- Candidates sit the tests at home, office etc. and do not need to travel to an EPSO location.
- > Such testing takes place via web conferencing/messaging software.
- All technical details are provided upfront, including the possibility to test the connection before the actual assessment day.
- It is foreseen to start and/or resume remote Assessment Centres before the end of this year.
- EPSO will inform candidates of all details, logistics and technical requirements at least 3 weeks in advance via their EPSO account.



## **Traineeships in the EU institutions**

If you would like to get a taster of a career with the EU, why not apply for a traineeship?

Each year around 1,200 young people are offered the chance to increase their professional skills, develop their personal qualities, and enhance their EU knowledge through the EU trainee programmes. Most of the EU institutions organise traineeships for young university graduates, each lasting usually between 3 and 5 months.

Traineeships are available in a wide range of fields and offer a great insight into the work of the EU. The content of the job largely depends on the service you are assigned to. Opportunities are available in the fields of competition law, human resources, environmental policy, communication and many more.

The selection procedures for traineeships are run by the individual EU institutions and agencies. You can see below the different opportunities available.


