It provides meals for children enrolled up to secondary school, ensuring a healthy and balanced diet. A personalised menu can be requested for ethical, religious or health reasons.

## HOME ASSISTANCE

Home support for the elderly to meet their needs for care, personal hygiene, daily tasks and socialisation.

## REST HOUSES

Participation in the cost of fees.

## DAILY ELDERLY CENTRES

Territorial structures with social, cultural and recreational activities.

## FRAGILE OLDER PEOPLE'S DAY CENTRES (CEDAF)

It takes in elderly people with partial self-sufficiency problems to meet their needs for socialisation, recovery and maintenance of psycho-physical abilities.

## PROTECTED HOSPITAL DISCHARGE

Help at home with both social and health services up to 60 days after discharge from in-patient institutions.

## ECONOMIC SUPPORT TO OVERCOME THE HOUSING EMERGENCY

To support people or families in situations of socio-economic hardship.

## ISSUANCE OF COTRAL CARDS AT REDUCED RATES TO ELDERLY PEOPLE WITH SOCIAL PENSIONS

To elderly people with social pensions, people with disabilities or situations of socio-economic hardship.

## MEALS AND DORMITORY ACCOMMODATION

For people with socio-economic difficulties meals and overnight stays at social canteens and reception.

## REGISTRATION TO VIA MODESTA VALENTI

registration to a fictitious residence for people with no fixed abode, permanently present in the territory and useful for obtaining identity documents and access to contributions, benefits and services.

## ASSISTED HEALTHCARE RESIDENCES (RSA).

Sharing in the cost of the rate of hospitality for the hotel quota of structures that offer 24-hour social and health assistance.



## FAMILY FOSTER CARE

Support for a minor who lacks a suitable family environment, and to support his/her family of origin.

## ADOPTION

Service accompanying married couples or couples with a demonstrable continuous cohabitation for at least 3 years, who intend to adopt a child.

## HOME ASSISTANCE (SAISH)

Individual intervention plan aimed at developing and maintaining self-sufficiency, autonomy and social integration of the disabled person.

## DISABLED PLATE

Issue of a placard to be affixed to the car, reserved for citizens with temporary or permanent motor disabilities residing in the Municipality, to grant them facilitations in the road circulation.

## DAY CARE CENTRES FOR THE DISABLED

To improve and enhance the degree of autonomy and self-sufficiency of the disabled, facilitate socialisation and contribute to the relief of families.
